

Living Allowance Increase

"Each year, AmeriCorps VISTA conducts a review of the living allowance to ensure compliance with our governing legislation. The review factors in the Health and Human Services poverty guidelines, as well as county-by-county cost of living data... As part of this year's living allowance review, AmeriCorps VISTA also accounted for the current 40-year historic high rate of inflation. As such, all members will receive at least a 7% living allowance increase... This year's living allowance increase will go into effect on August 14.
