WHEREAS: The Minnesota Alliance for Volunteer Advancement partners with organizations to provide resources, training, and networking opportunities to enhance the impact and effectiveness of volunteers and volunteer engagement professionals throughout Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Let's celebrate the impact of all volunteers in Minnesota and encourage individuals, groups, and families to become involved in their communities through volunteer service.
